Time Approximately 10-12 minutes

The skit starts with **David**, age 28, talking to the audience.

David: (*To audience*) I remember the first time I met Steve, we couldn't have

been more than five years old. I had no idea we would grow up

together. I had just moved into the neighborhood and we became best friends. We shared everything, always under the same philosophy:

"Friends Tell Friends Everything". We had no secrets.

Steve, age 5, enters rubbing his rear. Need quick pace to this dialogue.

David: (*Age 5*) Hi, whachya doin'?

Steve: Nothin'.

David: How come yer rubbin' yer bum?

Steve: 'Cuz.

David: 'Cuz why?

Steve: Got in trouble.

David: You got in trouble?

Steve: Yeah, got a spankin' and got grounded.

David: Got a spankin' and got grounded? Why? What were ya doin'?

Steve: 'Sperimentin'.

David: 'Sperimentin'?

Steve: Yeah.

David: What were ya 'sperimentin' with?

Steve: Parakeet.

David: Parakeet?

Steve: Yeah.

David: (*Laughs*) Whadya do with the parakeet?

Steve: Put him on my Big Wheel.

David: You put him on yer Big Wheel?

Steve: Yeah.

David: (Laughs) What ya use to get him on the Big Wheel?

Steve: Duct tape.

David: Duct tape?

Steve: Yeah.

David: (Laughs) You used duct tape to put yer parakeet on yer Big Wheel?

Steve: Yeah.

David: How come?

Steve: Wanted to see what kind of noise it would make.

David: What kind of noise did it make?

Steve: Kind of a tweet, clunk, tweet, clunk, tweet, crack.

David: Cool.

Steve: Yeah.

David: How is the parakeet now?

Steve: He was doing okay till we tried to take the duct tape off.

David: So you got a spankin' and grounded?

Steve: Yeah.

David: If you got grounded, how come yer out here with me?

David: (*Beat*) So.

David: No.

Steve: Loser.

David: (*Eager to please*) Got a cat.

Steve: Cool. Got any duct tape?

David: No.

Steve: Loser.

David: Got a staple gun!

Steve: Cool. Here kitty, kitty.

Steve exits.

David: (Age 28, to audience) That's how it started. We were inseparable. We

did everything together, went everywhere together, and told each other everything, because friends tell friends everything. We were together

even through the awkward years.

Steve, age 12, enters. **Steve** and **David** are now in sixth grade. Give them glasses, retainers or high voices. Something that shows they are awkward and hitting puberty.

Steve: Hey Davey.

David: (*Voice cracks constantly*) I told you, my name is David.

Steve: What's wrong with yer voice?

David: My mom says I'm becoming a man.

David: Can't tell you.

Steve: Can't tell me, how come?

David: Just can't.

Steve: Come on, friends tell friends everything.

David: All right. I can't go to the Jedi Club meeting 'cuz I'm going to the "Spring"

Fling" dance.

Steve: Yer going to the dance?

David: Yep.

Steve: Who ya going to the dance with?

David: Jenny.

Steve: Yer going to the dance with a girl?

David: Yep.

Steve: But what about the Jedi Club? You can't miss this meeting.

David: How come, what's so special about this meeting?

Steve: Can't tell you.

David: Can't tell me?

Steve: Nope.
