How This skit can easily be performed memorized or not (use black music stands and

have the actors read the script during performance). No blocking is necessary. The dialogue is spoken directly to the audience and the actors do not interact with one another. Each actor will represent several of the voices in our culture

that speak to what Love is, finally speaking what the Bible says Love is.

Time Approximately 3-4 minutes; This script is 3½ pages long.

Actors can be line up as Voice 1 Stage Right, Voice 2 Center Stage, Voice 3 Stage Left.

V3: Love has left the bedroom.

V2: Love is a one night fling.

Pause

V2: Love is friends and family.

V1: Love is prince charming and living happily.

V2: Love is like a dance.

V3: Love, after 2 kids and ten years has little to do with romance.

Pause

V1: Love?

V3: Love?

V2: Love.

V3: Love is spelled T-I-M-E

V2: Love is spelled R-E-S-P-E-C-T

V1: Love is spelled U-N-ME

V2: Love?

V1: Love?

V3: Love.

V1: Love sometimes has to say no.

V2: Love sometimes has to say yes.

V3: Love is more than a wedding dress.
