**Who** G1

G2 Lady

Hostess (optional)

When Present

Wear Two tables (Props) Two menus

Café set up (plates, cups, etc...)

Why Romans 3:23, John 3:16, Revelation 3:20,

**How** This should be very conversational, as if the characters are discussing a menu.

Timing is important for the script to flow correctly.

**Time** 2-3 minutes

Two women enter the café, sit in a booth and start looking at the menus. One lady is sitting at the table beside the two women.

**G2**: (Looking around) What is this place?

G1: The New Creation Café. It has apparently been here for a long time but I had never noticed it. I came here a few months ago with a friend.

**G2**: A couple months? If it's so good, why did you wait so long to bring me?

G1: I wasn't sure if you would like it.

G2: I can see why. Check out some of the stuff on this menu. I've never even heard of some of this stuff. What is patience? (Say with a French accent and then remark in an impressed tone) It sounds French.

G1: Oh, you don't want to get that today. I tried it last week and it kept...repeating... on me, if you know what I mean. I don't think I'll ever ask for that again.

Lady: (From the next table) Excuse me. I couldn't help but overhear what you just said. I had that trouble with patience myself until I tried it with a side of prayer. The difference is AMAZING.

**G1:** How much did you add?

Lady: Actually, I've found that the more prayer you add the more it aids digestion. I've started adding prayer to everything! One time I came and just ordered the prayer and I got peace for free.
