How Keep the dialogue moving and stay on top of your cues. Some of the humor

depends on perfectly timed pacing, so be sure to practice the "back and forth-

ness". It also helps to have someone watching and directing.

Time Approximately 3-5 minutes **Friend 2** sits reading scripture, as though he's on a park bench or somewhere outside, and **Friend 1** walks by.

**Friend 1:** Hey, what'cha reading?

Friend 2: Story.

Friend 1: Oh, yeah? Nice. I read sometimes, too. You know...in the

bathroom...billboards...restaurant menus...

Friend 2: (Laughs) Yeah? High fives for fitting it in where you can. (Returns to

being engrossed in book)

**Friend 1:** So...fiction or non-fiction?

**Friend 2:** Non-fiction, actually.

Friend 1: Snooze-fest?

Friend 2: Not at all. I can't quite get enough of it. It's like it's always new.

**Friend 1:** So you've read it before! (Notices the thickness) It's pretty thick...lots of

pages. But if it's good, I might give it a whirl. Does it have Cliff Notes?

Friend 2: Ha! Actually, it does, I think. And lots of people have retold it.

Friend 1: Like a remake, huh? Cool. Ooo! Maybe there's a movie I could watch!!

Could save me some time.

Friend 2: You know, people HAVE tried to tell the story through film, so...

Friend 1: Any live footage?

**Friend 2:** Oh, no. That would've been just about impossible.

**Friend 1:** Aw, it's a shame. So what's it about, anyway? Heroes? Villains?

Friendship? Betrayal? Face-eating zombies? ALIENS?? Love that stands

the test of time?

Friend 2: Um....

Yes.

Yes.

Yes.

Yes.

Not even a little bit.

Probably not the way you're thinking.

Aaaand, definitely.

**Friend 1:** Wow, sounds like it holds promise.



- **Friend 2:** That, too.
- **Friend 1:** So this hero...is he likeable? Or more of a reluctant champion, surprised by his own greatness?
- **Friend 2:** Definitely likeable. But not everybody was a fan. He was humble, but never seemed surprised at His purpose in life.
- **Friend 1:** Ahh, classic. Flawed yet self-assured...
- **Friend 2:** Well, no. According to this He lived flawlessly in a flawed world.
- Friend 1: Alright, now you've lost me. That just seems like a stretch. So what then, does he just live "happily ever after?"
- **Friend 2:** Well, I just read a part about how He was betrayed by someone in His inner circle, and it's like...there are all these villains everywhere...
- Friend 1: They turn on Mr. Perfect?? That doesn't sound flawless to me.
- **Friend 2:** Not from our perspective, no.
- **Friend 1:** Then how does it end? Does he teach his betrayer a lesson? Do the villains dissolve into bitter tears of regret and shame? How have I not seen this movie??
- **Friend 2:** Actually, at this point there's sort of a plot twist. The hero dies. He voluntarily dies. To save the villains.
- Friend 1: Nuh-UH!!
- Friend 2: Oh, but then He comes back to life.
- **Friend 1:** (Gasp) How does he do it? Faked his own death? Cloning?? Cryogentic freezing?!?! I mean, don't tell me. But tell me.
- Friend 2: Actually, His Father did it. Wanna know something even crazier? The hero ends up adopting some of His enemies into His own family.
- Friend 1: I gotta tell ya, at first I was like, "Huh." And then I was all, "WHAAAAT????"

  And now I'm sorta like, "(makes sound of a head explosion)!!"
- **Friend 2:** I know, right? It's pretty incredible.
- **Friend 1:** Look, I've gotta go, but will you write down the name of this book for me so I won't forget? I've gotta check this out for myself.
