How This script takes good comic timing. Keep the energy up and the dialogue

moving. Make sure there is a distinct difference between Jordan and Brad, Jordan being a nervous wreck and Brad being completely oblivious to his

mistake.

Time Approximately 5-6 minutes

Jordan: I can't believe we are lost, seriously we're in the middle of nowhere and

we are lost. WE ARE SO LOST!

Brad: We're not lost, we're just not...found.

Something flies over both of their heads and they hit the ground. Jordan screams.

Jordan: What was that?

Brad: Just a hawk. We'll be fine.

Jordan: Will we, WILL WE?! You know people die from getting lost.

Brad: Aren't you being a little dramatic there, Jordan.

Jordan: They do. Bears attack. Or lions. Or sasquatches.

Brad: Sasquatches?

Jordan: I saw it on an episode of Unsolved Mysteries.

Brad: We'll be fine. I know there's got to be a way to get to the campsite from

here. This is a shortcut.

Jordan: How is this a shortcut? We've been walking FOREVER!

Brad: Fine it's a...long cut. (Beat) Just get off my back, okay? I know where we

are. It's not like the map would have gotten us there any quicker.

Jordan: Map? What map?

Brad immediately realizes he has said too much.

Brad: What are you talking about? I didn't say map?

Jordan: Yes you did. You said there was a map. Do you have a map?

Brad: No.

Jordan: Do you?

Brad: No.

Jordan: Do you?!

Brad: Maybe.

Jordan: Are you serious?!

Brad: Is it really that important if I do or don't have a map?

Jordan: Yes, it is very important!

Brad: Calm down.

Jordan: Don't tell me to calm down! We've been walking in circles for hours now

trying to find this campsite and you're telling me you had a map all

along?

Brad: Yeah, so.

Jordan: SO?! So, why haven't we followed it? Huh? Why haven't you even taken it

out?

Brad: Just calm down.

Jordan: I am calm. For how angry I am right now, this is calm! This is as calm as a

Chinese peace lily.

desires us to go a completely different way. Scripture says that God's Word is "A lamp to our feet and a light for our path." It, along with the Holy Spirit, reveals God's path for our lives. Are you following God's map,

or simply wandering around lost?
