How Keep the dialogue conversational and energetic.

Time Approximately 2 minutes

Four people walk onstage on a hot, sunny day. **Ryan** and **Kat** enter from stage right. **Drew** and **Laura** enter from stage left. Everyone is sweaty and fanning themselves.

Ryan: Okay!

Laura: It's so hot!

Drew: Whew!

Ryan: Kind of a hot day.

Drew: Ya think?

Kat: (Fanning herself) Ugh. It's SOO hot!

Drew: Three months and no rain is called a drought, right?

Ryan: That's what I'm saying.

Laura: That's right.

Kat: (Annoyed) What are we doing out here?!

Ryan: (Cheerfully) Okay, guys, I just thought we should meet and pray for rain.

Okay?

Laura: (Into the idea) That's a great idea! Let's pray!

Ryan: I mean, it can't hurt.

Drew: (Rolling his eyes) Well, get on with it!

Ryan: Okay, so, join hands. Prayer works better that way.

All four reach out to hold hands. **Kat** will only touch fingers. **Drew** will only fan himself with his clothes.
