- What** On that day, September 11th, 2001 our world was forever changed. But ten years later we know that God is still watching over us. **Themes:** September 11th, Hope, Faith, Love, Courage, Heroes
- Who** Reader 1  
Reader 2  
Reader 3  
Reader 4-\*optional
- When** Present
- Wear (Props)** Actors can wear casual clothes or coordinating colors. Another idea is to have actors all in black.  
All Readers should have a black 3-ring binder for script.
- Why** Genesis 1:1-4; 2 Samuel 22:5, 7; 2 Chronicles 20:9; Psalm 80:7; 1 Corinthians 13:11-13
- How** If you only have 3 Readers, simply reassign Reader 4's lines to Reader 1. This script would go great before or after a prayer for our country, before a worship song or hymn, or before or after a moment of silence. Another idea is to light candles and/or play soft music during the reading. You could have someone sing Amazing Grace acapella. Be careful not to be overly dramatic. Pushing emotions will only create awkwardness. Instead, read with reverence and conviction.

- Time** Approximately 3-4 minutes

*Readers address the audience.*

**Reader 1:** On that day, we went and fulfilled our normal, busy schedules.

**Reader 2:** In a rhythm,

**Reader 3:** In a routine.

**Reader 4:** (Gen. 1:1-4) "In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. Now the earth was without shape and empty, and darkness was over the surface of the watery deep, but the Spirit of God was moving over the surface of the water. God said, 'Let there be light,' and there was light!" God saw that the light was good, so God separated the light from the darkness."

**Reader 1:** On that day, we heard the news which we could not comprehend.

**Reader 2:** We saw the sight that shook our very foundation.

**Reader 3:** We felt the impact that shook every one of us to the core.

**Reader 4:** (2 Samuel 22:5, 7) "The waves of death engulfed me, the ropes of the grave tightened around me. In my distress I called to the Lord; I called to my God."

**Reader 1:** On that day, we stood in disbelief.

**Reader 2:** We wept.

**Reader 3:** We prayed.

**Reader 4:** (2 Chronicles 20:9) "If disaster comes on us in the form of a military attack, judgment or plague or famine, we will stand in front of this temple before you, for you are present in this temple. We will cry out to you in our distress, and you will hear us and deliver us."
