- What** This is a responsive reading for a Thanksgiving service filled with Scripture about praising God for his many blessings. (Themes: thankful, blessings, grateful, love enduring, Thanksgiving, freedom, surrender, prayer)
- Who** Reader 1
Reader 2
Reader 3
Reader 4
- When** Present
- Wear
(Props)** Black binders for scripts
- Why** Psalm 9:1; Psalm 50:23; Phil. 4:6; 2 Thess. 1:3
- How** This is a traditional reader’s theatre, but of course, you can use your creativity to use the script however you’d like. If you want to take out the congregation lines you can split those lines between Reader’s 2 and 3. Reader 1 will be saying the things we as a congregation feel and have been through- he or she is our voice. As the piece progresses, the readers should build up the energy. You can also use music to help build throughout the script. See the director’s notes at the end of the script.
*Congregation is shortened to “Cong”.
- Time** Approximately 3-5 minutes

Reader 1: This Thanksgiving let us be reminded of the many blessings we have been given.

Reader 2: I will give thanks to the Lord with my whole heart; I will recount all of your wonderful deeds.
-Psalm 9:1

Reader 1: This Thanksgiving let us look back on the year we have had and surrender all -knowing God is in control of the steps we take.

Reader 3: The one who offers thanksgiving as his sacrifice glorifies me; to one who orders his way rightly I will show the salvation of God!"
-Psalm 50:23

Cong: It is good to give thanks to the Lord, to sing praises to your name, O Most High;
-Psalm 92:1

Reader 1: My God, I thank you for the good and the bad times knowing each season of life can draw me closer to you.

Reader 2: Do not be anxious about anything, but in everything, by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving, let your requests be made known to God.
-Philippians 4:6

Reader 1: Today, no matter what my circumstances are, I say thank you for another day that I may draw a breath to praise you for what you have done.

Cong: Oh give thanks to the Lord; call upon his name; make known his deeds among the peoples! Sing to him, sing praises to him; tell of all his wondrous works!
-Psalm 105:1-2

Reader 1: I have held back long enough. I have made it about me. Not anymore. I step aside and want to catch a glimpse of your majesty; of your glory.
