- What** The character of God and foundation for theology is explained through a simple child's prayer. **Themes:** God's Character, Theology, Bible, Goodness, Greatness, Provision
- Who** Actor 1
Actor 2

- When** Present
- Wear (Props)** Four black binders if Actors are reading their scripts.
- Why** Deuteronomy 10:17; Job 37:5
- How** Each part should be read with a lot of energy and passion. Really personalize the words and think about what you're saying. Don't merely read the words, but communicate them to your audience. For best results, memorize your lines and incorporate blocking, or stage direction, with each actor.
- One idea is to use this script as your message and incorporate music between each section.
- Time** Approximately 6-8 minutes

Actors enter and address the audience.

Actor 1: God is great.

Actor 2: God is good.

Actor 3: Let us thank him for our food.

Actor 1: I bet you didn't know that when you were a kid and prayed that prayer, you were praying a solid foundation for a study on theology.

Actor 4: I bet you didn't know that you had a deep outline of our beliefs in God.

Actor 3: Three quick phrases.

Actor 2: Three declarations of God's character.

Actor 1: God is great!

Actor 4: He is supreme and divine!

Actor 3: He is big and he is powerful!

Actor 2: Think of the biggest thing or concept that you can think of.

Actor 4: The universe or the farthest star.

Actor 1: Expand your mind as wide as it can go.

Actor 3: Then imagine all of that as a grain of sand in God's hand,

Actor 1: and you're still short-changing him.

Actor 2: He is omnipresent.

Actor 4: He is not bound by space.

Actor 3: He is everywhere all the time.

Actor 2: *(Psalm 139: 7-8)* "Where can I go to escape your spirit? Where can I flee to escape your presence?"

Actor 4: "If I were to ascend to heaven you'd be there. If I make my bed in the depths there you would be."

Actor 1: God is omniscient.

Actor 3: He knows everything.

Actor 2: Not only does God know everything, he is wise!

Actor 4: He knows all the facts and acts the right way.

Actor 1: God is omnipotent.

Actor 2: He is not limited in power.

Actor 3: In fact, he is able to supersede the universal laws of physics.

Actor 4: He parted the Red Sea.

Actor 2: Jesus walked on the water.

Actor 3: He also stilled a storm.

Actor 4: Jesus was raised from the dead.

Actor 1: *(Matthew 19:26)* Jesus looked at them and replied, "This is impossible for mere humans, but for God all things are possible."

Actor 4: God is great. His greatness is evident in the creation of the earth...

Actor 2: And in His involvement in our lives.

Actor 1: God is good.

Actor 3: What is good?

Actor 1: Webster's defines "good" as "morally excellent"

Actor 2: Virtuous

Actor 3: Righteous

Actor 4: Satisfactory in quality, quantity or degree.

Actor 3: There are over forty-five definitions of the word "good" in the dictionary.

Actor 1: But does this sum up God's character? Can God be described in these forty-five definitions of "good?"

Actor 3: Maybe we're saying it the wrong way. Maybe we have it backwards.

Actor 4: We shouldn't look at God and say "Hey! God happens to be doing good things!"

Actor 1: Rather, we must redefine "good."

Actor 2: When God created the world...he was good.

- Actor 3:** When God flooded the earth...he was good.
- Actor 4:** When God destroyed Sodom and Gomorrah...he was good.
- Actor 2:** When God rescued the Israelites from captivity...he was good.
- Actor 3:** When God allowed all the firstborn in Egypt to be killed...he was good.
- Actor 1:** When God allowed Jesus to be crucified...God was good.
- Actor 4:** When God allowed Job the Righteous to suffer...God was good.
- Actor 2:** When God allowed dictators to kill thousands of people...God was good.
- Actor 3:** When you were born...God was good.
- Actor 2:** When you failed that test...God was good.
- Actor 4:** When your parents got a divorce...God was good.
- Actor 1:** When those who do not accept God spend eternity apart from Him...God is good.
- Actor 4:** The goodness of God doesn't change with our circumstances.
- Actor 1:** Nor, does the presence of evil and bad things diminish the perfect goodness of God.
- Actor 2:** God is without sin. God has no faults.
- Actor 1:** God is perfect.
