- Who** Adam

- When** Adam and Eve in their later years
- Wear  
(Props)** Biblical wear with some contemporary adornments like a baseball cap for Adam and apron for Eve...be creative
- Why** Genesis 2:7-25
- How** Keep the dialogue conversational and natural. It would be endearing if the couple playing these roles were actually married.
- Time** Approximately 4 minutes

*Adam is dozing in a rocking chair as on front porch. Eve enters and sighs.*

**Eve:** Oh, what a beautiful day. *(Looking around)* Look at those flowers, all the colors and *(breathes in)* wonderful fragrances. *(Sees Adam is sleeping)* Wake up, Adam! How can you sleep on such a glorious day?

**Adam:** *(groggy)* Five more minutes.

**Eve:** No, you need to wake up now. There are things to do, places to see, some more animals to name.

**Adam:** *(slowly waking)* Oh, we can name the rest of the animals later.

**Eve:** *(taps Adam harder)* Now!

**Adam:** *(sees Eve)* Well, hello! Where have you been all my life? *(Looks up and whispers loudly)* Thank you, God! *(Leans toward Eve for a kiss)*

**Eve:** I think you are still dreaming. *(Pushes Adam away in a loving way)* You'd better save your energy fellow. We've got lots to do today. Remember, we promised to keep the grandkids this afternoon.

**Adam:** What? I thought God was finished punishing us!

**Eve:** *(crosses arms and stares at Adam)*
