(Props)** Apple
- Why** 1 Thessalonians 4:1-8; 1 Corinthians 6:18-20
- How** This is a sensitive subject and should be performed by two girls who are very confident on stage. In fact, if this script is being performed for a youth group, it may be a good idea to have two college girls playing teenagers. Also, change the name of the boy mentioned in the script, Ryan, to another name if you have a Ryan in your youth group.
- Time** Approximately 5-7 minutes

Laura and Kat walk onstage together, in the midst of their conversation. Kat is carrying an apple with her.

Laura: I just think Ryan is so cute!

Kat: Yeah, he's pretty cute. You guys make a great couple.

Laura: Do you think so? I mean, he's such a great guy. I can't believe he'd really go out with me for so long.

Kat: You guys *have* been dating for a long time.

Laura: Did you know that next week is our one-year anniversary?

Kat: Wow! That IS a long time!

Laura: I know! Do you realize how long that is in girl time? That's like...

Both: *(Excitedly)* FIVE years!

Laura: It's such a big deal! I want to give Ryan something really meaningful for our anniversary. I've been thinking about it for a couple of months, and I know exactly what I want to give him.

Kat: Oh yeah? You do need to give him something special. So what are you thinking of?

Laura: *(Confident and excited)* Well, I've decided that for our anniversary, I want to give Ryan - myself.

Kat: *(Oblivious)* But you're already dating. That doesn't make any sense. Okay, I have an idea. You guys should plant a tree together. You know, plant it, and water it, and watch it grow. That'd be so romantic!

Laura: Uh, right. Yeah. Maybe *you* could do that. I don't really think that's what I'm looking for.

Kat: Yeah, maybe that's dumb. Well, we can think of something else. We could go shopping and maybe find something really cool for him.

Laura: *(A bit frustrated)* But I already told you what I want to give him.

Kat: *(Mystified)* What?

Laura: I told you- I want to give Ryan ... *myself*. *(Kat looks at Laura, totally not understanding what she's saying.)* You know, *all* of me. Are you following? I mean, it's the perfect gift. He'll for sure know how much I love him.

Kat: *(Starting to understand)* Wait. You mean like you...and Ryan...and no clothes?

Kat is obviously not pleased with Laura's decision.

Laura: Well, if that's the way you want to put it, yes. Boy, you make it sound so unromantic. Anyway, I'm really excited, but I'm kind of nervous too. I was thinking maybe we could go shopping and pick out the right outfit or something. I want it to be perfect, ya know?

Kat: Look, Laura, I think it's great that you two have been dating for so long, but I was just kind of wondering- what do you think *God* thinks about this?

ENDING:

Kat: *(Still chewing the apple)* Don't get me wrong, I'm very excited for your anniversary. I think it's great you two have been dating for so long.

Kat bites the apple again.

Laura: Um...man, that apple is making me hungry. Uh, could I have a bite? I haven't eaten since breakfast.

Kat: *(Still chewing, speaking through a mouthful of apple)* You want some of this? But this is my apple. Apples are a precious commodity.

Laura: Hey, I thought we were friends! All I want is a bite!

Kat: Okay, fine. You can have some.

Kat takes another bite.

Laura: Thank you! *(Laura reaches for the apple. Kat grabs Laura's hand and spits the apple she's been chewing into it.)* GROSS! What's wrong with you? What are you doing? You've already chewed this! That's disgusting!

Kat: So tell me, how does it feel to get something that's been used?

Laura glares at Kat until her point sinks in. Kat walks offstage. Laura walks offstage in the opposite direction.

Lights fade. The end.
