How Have fun with this skit! During his sermon, your Pastor may refer to the "box

city" as he preaches about being committed to the body of believers. This skit leaves plenty of opportunities for you to personalize it for your audience and

community.

Time Approximately 3-4 minutes

Todd enters wearing ripped pants and a tattered shirt. He is barefoot and looks like he's "been through it". Wilson, the volleyball, is placed on stage. Part of the stage is set up with a bunch of boxes all different shapes and sizes. If you can get some refrigerator boxes it can make the places that are references to feel more like actual "locations".

Todd: Wilson! Wilson! Where are you?! Where you y-oh...there you are. Wilson,

don't ever wander off like that again. (Looking at volleyball- has the same face as "Wilson" did in the movie, Castaway) I can't find you when you wander off to this place. (Pointing to box) I know you like Jamba Juice, but who do you think pays for all the protein berry pizzazz? That's right! I do! (You can put in whatever restaurant, fast food joint and certain type of food you want in place of Jamba and Protein Berry Pizzazz)

Rescuer: Hello? Hello? Anyone here?

Todd: Uh...we are. (Holding Wilson)

Rescuer: Sir, you've been rescued! We've noticed movement down on the island

and decided to get a closer look. You said "we". There are others?

Todd: Rescued. Wow! I can't believe this. Wilson, we've been rescued!

Rescuer: Who's Wilson? Where is he?

Todd: Right here. (Holding up Wilson and showing the face; to **Rescuer**) Let's

go!
