**Wear** The setting is in an office hallway, so anything you can do to make it look like

**(Props)** one is great. Briefcases for each actor.

**Why** Romans 6

**How** Dialogue should be casual and the actors should be comfortable with one

another. Keep the pacing up, especially towards the end. There is an abrupt

ending, which will lend to the humor.

**Time** Approximately 3-5 minutes

Two women, **Nancy** and **Marci**, meet at the office door as they both leave from work. They both carry briefcases and are obviously executive types.

**Nancy**: Hey Marci, how'd your day go? You making any progress on that

DayStar proposal?

**Marci**: Yeah, sorta. The thing's a black hole. I just can't seem to get ahead on it.

Thanks for asking though....

**Nancy**: Sure ... no problem. *(concerned, but not pushy)* Hey Marc, it seems like

you've been a little ... distracted lately.

**Marci**: Distracted? *(a bit hesitant to reveal anything)* Oh, I don't know.

**Nancy**: Has Jackson loaded you up with more accounts since the layoffs?

**Marci**: Oh, no more that anybody else. It's just ---

**Nancy**: (interrupting) You need me to put in a good word for you with Jackson?

**Marci**: No ... no, I'm fine, really. Work's actually going pretty well.

**Nancy**: *(fishing for the real problem)* So... how's your love life?

**Marci**: *(chuckles)* Distracting.

**Nancy**: You still going out with that guy?

Marci: Jeff?

**Nancy**: Yeah, Jeff. The salesman, right?

**Marci**: Yeah, the salesman.

**Nancy**: So... are you still dating him?

Marci: No. I'm definitely NOT still dating him.

**Nancy**: *(still fishing)* So ... is that good news?

**Marci**: Oh yeah, that's definitely good news.

**Nancy**: So, are you dating somebody else?

Marci: Nope.

**Nancy**: (still fishing; trying to understand the problem) But you're kind of a

little..."iffy" about breaking up with Jeff?

**Marci**: No! Not at all. Breaking up with Jeff is the best thing I ever did. The guy

was a total jerk. All he did was drag me down. I mean, this guy was totally self-absorbed. The whole time I dated him we only did stuff that he wanted to do. And all of it was lousy stuff. I mean, lousy stuff. The guy thought the whole world revolved around him. I've never known a
