How **If you are acting the monologue on stage**, be imaginative and use the space to re-enact the actor’s emotions, using the space and your body’s movements.

If you are reading for Zoom, read it with passion and emotion, and don’t be afraid to take your time. Look in at the audience or into the computer camera. Ensure all your notifications are turned off and emails are closed and have the PDF on screen near the camera.

If you read the script from the pulpit, be familiar enough with your lines so that your head isn’t down in the script the entire time. Look audience members in the eye. Take time to pause and breathe. Embrace the awe and mystery of the scripture.

Time Approximately 3-4 minutes

Actor enters and addresses the audience.

Thank you for your empowering grace and for your constant provision.

Thank you that you make all things new, God! That your word never returns to you void. And that it does a new thing. In us. Around us. In our hearts. In our lives.

Thank you that we are taking the shape you want us to take because you are the Potter and we are the clay.
