Themes: America, 4th of July, Freedom, Unity, Independence Day

Who *Group 1: Group 2:*

Reader 1 (Dad) Reader 4 Reader 2 (Mom) Reader 5

Reader 3 (Child)

When Present day fireworks display

Wear Summertime clothes

(Props) blankets, picnic baskets, mini flags – if desired

Props can be used as much or as sparingly as possible.

How This can be decked out as much or as little as desired. Readers can stand in 2

groupings as if they came together to find a spot at the fireworks. This script would be perfect to set up a song. Music can be played "under" the dialogue as

well.

Time Approximately 3 minutes

Readers should stand with their grouping as though they're about to watch a fireworks display.

All: There's something kind of exciting here, isn't there?

Reader 3: Will I have a good seat?

Reader 4: Will the weather play nice?

Reader 2: Did I bring enough snacks...?

Reader 5: ...drinks and bug spray...

Reader 3: Can I have a glow-in-the-dark sword? The hat? Ooo, the spinny thing!!"

Reader 4: Think it'll be better than last year?

Reader 1: Is that tree gonna be in the way...?

Reader 3: Hope the finale is HUGE!

Reader 1: Am I sitting in ants...?

Reader 2: ...well, you're just gonna have to hold it, because we're nowhere near a rest room...

Reader 5: Tell me if you see the cotton candy cart...

Reader 4: What time is this thing supposed to start?

Reader 1: ... DEFINITELY SITTING IN ANTS!!

All: There's something quite good in community, isn't there?

Reader 1: We may not agree much.

Reader 3: It's likely we won't.

Reader 5: But today – tonight - ...

Reader 2: We're not My Side...

Reader 1: ...and Your Side.

Reader 4: We're here.

Reader 5: We're together.

All: We're Americans.

Reader 2: And if just for tonight, our states feel United.

Reader 1: If just for tonight, our attention's undivided.

Reader 4: We celebrate our beginnings.
