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- What** An updated take on a classic Scrooge tale. **Themes:** Selfishness, Serving, Attitude, Giving
- Who** BA Humbug-a grumpy older Scrooge-like man
Mrs. Soann-So- Church worker
Freely Give-an angel (same actor as Mrs. Soann-So)
- When** Present
- Wear (Props)** Laptop
Clipboard
Freely Give could be dressed in white to give an angelic appearance
Doorbell or knocking sound effect
- Why** Luke 6:31, Psalm 119:36
- How** The set needs to include a front porch and inside of house. This can be imaginary. Just make sure the actors clearly define the spaces for the audience.
- Time** Approximately 2-4 minutes

Knock at the door or doorbell. BA goes to answer it.

Mrs. Soann-So: Good day Mr... *(pauses and looks at paper)* Bug is it?

BA: HUMbug! B.A. Humbug

Mrs. Soann-So: Oh, yes. HELLO! I'm Mrs. Soann-So from Every Church, the little brick church on the corner of Each and Every Street. Our records indicate that you and your daughter, Penny, attended once a long, LONG time ago.

BA: *(Grunts gruffly)*

Mrs. Soann-So: Uh—well, anyway. Our church is planning a Children's Dramatic production to reach out to our community and we need all the children to take part. Is Penny available?

BA: No,

Mrs. Soann-So: *(Nervous laughing)* Well, Mr. Humbug, it would be a great...

BA: NO!

Mrs. Soann-So: Most everyone in the community is taking part. For instance, the Talent family sent their son Able to help write the play, build the set and score the music. The Minutes sent their daughter Justa but she has to leave soon, prior obligations. The Utilities sent little Billy to run the lights, he is quite prompt but he sure takes a lot of energy. We really need Penny. She has a way of making everyone else do their job more effectively.

BA: NO!

He shuts the door grunting and muttering, turns to find Freely Give in his house. Spotlight on her to look angelic.

BA: *(Startled)* Who are you?

Freely Give: *(In a high pitched angelic voice)* I'm FREELY, FREELY GIVE!

BA: You gotta be kiddin' me.
