Readers address the audience.

Reader 1: Here's one last pop quiz for our graduating class...

Reader 2: It's only one question. There's no right or wrong answer. And you can start studying for it when the test begins.

Reader 3: Are you ready?

Reader 2: Here's the question...

Reader 1: What do you need to survive in life? At first, you might answer: "Food, water, shelter, pizza...you know, the basics. And that would be a pretty good answer.

Reader 3: But you'd be missing a few essential elements.

Reader 2: OK, here's the cheat sheet...

Reader 3: It's three words:

Reader 1: faith,

Reader 2: hope

Reader 3: and love.

Reader 1: Let's start with faith. Where do you put it? Is it in yourself, your gifts, your talents and abilities?

Reader 2: Or do you put your faith in the One who came to save us?

Reader 3: And then hope. Where do you put your hope?

Reader 2: Great relationships, being successful, or making a lot of money some day?

Reader 3: Or do you put your hope in eternal things?

Reader 2: And finally, love. The Bible says a lot about love, and Jesus boils it down to this:

Reader 1: Love God.

Reader 3: Love others.

Reader 2: It's not as complicated as we make it.

Reader 1: In this world, you are God's hands and feet.

Reader 3: You are the ones that get tell the world about the only perfect love.

Reader 2: The perfect love that casts out all fear.

Reader 1: Faith,

Reader 2: hope,

Reader 3: and love.

Reader 1: You see, when you have those three...even in the darkest times...there's still light that you can cling to and light that you can share.

Reader 2: Faith, hope, and love.

Reader 3: Let those be the markers that people know you by.
