many minutes for numerous elements. With this RR, feel free to cut some parts

out to fit length or your church service.

Note to Programmer or Worship Leader: The song "His Love Endures Forever"

could be a perfect fit after this script.

Time Approximately 2-3 minutes

Actors enter and begin reading.

Actor 1: God, I want to have a thankful heart. How do I do that?

Actor 2: God, I will start at the top of the list. You are at the very top.

Actor 1: Even though my life sometimes doesn't reflect it.

Actor 3: God, I am thankful for you.

Actor 2: I praise you.

Actor 1: I worship you.

Actor 2: God says to us, "They will be my people, and I will be their God." (Jer. 32:38)

Actor 3: God says to us, "I will give them singleness of heart so they will always fear me for their own good and the good of their children after them." (Jer. 32:39)

Actor 1: God says to us, "I will make an everlasting covenant with them: I will never stop doing good to them, and I will inspire them to fear me, so that they will never turn away from me." (Jer. 32:40)
