When Present

Wear (Props) God, Jesus, and Holy Spirit can wear white polo shirts and ball caps with whistles around their necks to look like coaches.
Everyone else should wear gym clothes, as if they've been playing basketball.

Why Isaiah 55:8; Proverbs 3:5-6

How Keep things moving and the dialogue conversational. As the actors are "playing basketball" they can either use a real basketball, or to avoid any mishaps can pantomime a basketball.

Time Approximately 2-4 minutes

Guys 1, 2 and 3 and Persons A, B and C are onstage.

Guy 1: Hey, want to play?

Person A: Yeah. *(Start a game of basketball. Person B and C are pretty good, but Person A is terrible.)*

Guy 2: You're horrible.

Guy 3: I thought you were bringing you're a-game?

Person C: Leave him alone.

Person B: *(To Person A and Person B)* Oh no.

Person A: What?

Person B: It's God again. He's going to try and get us to play for him.

Person A: You know they actually won the games against the Egyptians and the Philistines last night.

Person B: Seriously? With those jokers playing?

Person C: No way.

Holy Spirit: Hey guys.

Person A: Hey.

God: I wanted to introduce you to my Son, Jesus. He's also on the team.

Person B: Nice to meet you.

Person C: *(Aside)* I think I've heard about him.

Person A: *(Aside)* He actually seems like he might be a good player.

Person B: *(Aside)* Yeah.

Person A: *(To Jesus)* So, what game are you playing in?

ENDING:

God: No. You are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people belonging to God that you might declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his marvelous light.

Person A exits following God, HS, and Jesus. Lights out. The end.
