How Keep this light and energetic. The dialogue should be conversational.

Time Approximately 3-4 minutes

Tim and **Alan** are standing facing the audience as if they are looking at Alan's front yard.

Tim: Hey Alan. Wow, the lawn is looking really great.

Alan: Oh thanks, Tim. Yeah, I put a lot of hard work into it.

Tim: What's your secret? I can't seem to get my yard so green and lush.

Alan: Well, it's just a lot of time and attention and a good fertilizer.

Tim: Huh. Well, you're a shoo-in for this year's neighborhood lawn award.

You've won the past 2 years, right?

Alan: Three, but it's no big deal. (under his breath) It's just a good thing they

don't look in the backyard.

Tim: Huh?

Alan: What?

Tim: What did you just say?

Alan: Nothing.

Tim: Yes you did. You just said something about your backyard.

Alan: No, no I said...I said...the key is to mow backwards.

Tim: Mow backwards?

Alan: Right, you mow backwards.
