Wear This is set in a church-you can either use pews or chairs

(Props) Easter bonnet that is very big and extravagant with flowers, greenery, ribbons,

bows, etc. attached to hat

Why Matthew 28:1-8, Proverbs 21:3-4

How Keep the dialogue energetic and stay on top of your cues- don't let it drag. Be

sure to practice trimming the hat so you'll avoid surprises during a performance.

Time Approximately 4-6 minutes

Brent and Kim hurry to their seats in a worship service.

Brent: Great, I was afraid someone might have gotten our seats. You know how

it is on Easter Sunday...people all over the place! They think they can

just sit anywhere!

Kim: Just sit down. We are fine. (*They both sit.*)

Brent: We would have been here a lot earlier if you had not been on the phone

for so long.

Kim: I was wishing your mother a happy Easter!

Brent: Well, at least we were lucky enough to find a good parking place.

Kim: You blocked another car in!

Brent: Don't worry. We'll just leave when the last song starts and we can beat

everyone out. That will give us a head start on getting to lunch before

the crowds.

Kim: What a relaxing Easter this is turning out to be!

Brent: Ssh...things are getting started.

A **Lady** arrives in the worship service and sits in front of **Brent** and **Kim**. She is wearing a huge hat as described earlier. This should block the view of **Brent** and **Kim**. The rest of the sketch should be done with **Brent** and **Kim** peering around the hat. The woman's movements and positioning should hinder them from seeing.

Brent: What is this? When did the florist open a store in the row in front of us?

Kim: Honey, she'll hear you.

Brent: She won't hear me...the leaves are sticking in her ears.

Kim: Now Brent, it is Easter. People like to dress up on Easter...nice

dresses...new shoes...fancy hats.

Brent: I can't see anyone dressed like that because of this wall in front of me.

Kim: Can you see the pastor?

Brent: If I lean this way, I can see his right eye...no, too late. He disappeared

into the flowers. How about you?

Kim: (Kneels) When I get down on my knees, I can see his chin.

Brent: Get up, Kim! Someone might think you are praying!



Kim: (Returns to her seat) Do you want to change seats with me?

Brent: We can try. (Starts to move behind **Kim** to trade seats with her) Be

careful. Don't hit the hat. There may be thorns in it!

Kim: Is that any better?

Brent: I can't believe it!

Kim: You can see now?

Brent: No, the hat is even bigger on this side!

ENDING:

Kim: Why don't we just slip out early and go home?

Brent: No, I came to church on Easter Sunday and nothing is going to stop me

from the whole experience...I am going to see it all!

Kim: How are you going to do that?

Brent gets up and starts heading forward.

Kim: (Stands) Where are you going?

Brent: The choir is getting ready to sing and they have the best seats in the

house! I am going to join them!

Kim: You can't just go up there and sing.

Brent: Watch me! (Runs off singing "Here Comes Peter Cottontail")

Kim: (Kneels down behind the **Lady** with the hat until completely hidden) I'd

rather not.

Lights out. The end.

*NOTE: Drama could lead into prayer of confession...what barriers are keeping us from fully focusing on God?
