Billy: Zacchaeus video.

Time Approximately 6-8 minutes

Tommy is on his knees and becomes "Billy" a little boy in Sunday School. **Eddie** is next to him and is the Sunday School teacher.

Eddie: Alright, class, I'm going to be your Sunday School teacher this morning.

Tommy: Hi! Hi!

Eddie: I'm your substitute teacher. My name is Mr. Drummond.

Tommy: What 'chu talkin' 'bout?

Eddie: Well I'm going to tell you what I'm talking about. What's your name?

Tommy: My name's Billy. Like the goat! (Makes a goat sound) But I'm not really a

goat.

Eddie: You're a little boy. Okay. Well, we're going to talk about grace.

Tommy: Oh I know Grace. I know all about Grace. She's in my other class.

Eddie: No, no...

Tommy: She's pretty. She makes me feel funny.

Eddie: This is a different type of grace.

Tommy: Oh there's another girl named Grace?

Eddie: No, it's a concept that I will teach you about through a song about a guy

named Zacchaeus.

Tommy: Oh, Zacharias.

Eddie: No, Zacchaeus.

Tommy: Zucchini. Zoology. Zaboomafoo!

Eddie: No, I need you just to listen, okay? I'm going to teach you about

Zacchaeus through a song.

Tommy: Oh I love to sing! I love to sing (sings) songs to God! Like I love to sing

(sings and does sign language) Jesus loves me, this I know! For the Bible done told me so ("so" becomes "sew" in his sign language motion)... I'm

gonna be the next American Idol.

Eddie: Sure you are. Hey, what is this? (He imitates **Tommy's** sign language of

"so" in which **Tommy** pretends to "sew".)

Tommy: Oh, it's "the Bible told me so" like you're sewing. My grandmother sews

Bible verses into my underwear in case I have an accident.



Eddie: And I bet a little kid like you, you probably do have accidents, right?

(Tommy makes a face like he's "having an accident") Okay, it goes like this: (begins to sing) Zaccheus was a wee little man- (Tommy giggles)

Billy...Billy? What is it? What's the matter?

Tommy: I just did.

Eddie: Okay, here we go. Okay, it goes like this: (begins to sing) Zaccheus was a

wee little man- (*Tommy* giggles, *Eddie* tries again) Zacchaeus what a wee little man- (*Tommy* giggles again) Billy, what is it? Why are you

laughing?

Tommy: 'Cause you said "wee".

Eddie: "Wee" means "small".

Tommy: Yeah, it means something else too!

Eddie: Okay, I really need you to listen. Zaccheus was a wee little man (*Tommy*

bursts into laughter again) and a wee little man was he... (Tommy is

laughing harder) What is so funny?
