20 oz. Bottle of Coke

Why Psalm 106:15; 1 Corinthians 7:7; Exodus 20:17; Mark 7:20-23; Philippians 3:8

How Keep the energy and pacing up and the dialogue conversational. Also, keep

entrances and exits smooth by staying on top of cues.

Time Approximately 2-4 minutes

Jesus walks onstage with two identically-wrapped gift bags. One contains an 8oz can of Coke; the other has a 20oz bottle of Coke. He holds the 8oz bag in his left hand and the 20oz bag in his right hand. He stands waiting to give the gifts to Laura and Drew. Laura enters and stands on stage left of Jesus. Drew enters and stands on stage right.

Jesus: Hey, guys! I got you each a gift!

Laura: No way, Jesus! Why?

Drew: Awesome!

Jesus: I just love you guys, so I wanted to get you something!

Drew: That's so nice!

Jesus: (Handing Laura her gift) Laura- you first.

Laura: Wow, this is so exciting! (She opens her gift and is excited to find an 80z

can of Coke) Oh, will you look at this? A little 8 ounce can of Coke! This is

perfect for me!

Jesus: (Smiling) I looked everywhere to find a gift for you, and this just seemed

to fit.

Laura: I love it!

Jesus: (Turning to **Drew**, handing him his gift) Drew?

Drew: Yeah?

Jesus: (Excitedly) Your turn!

Drew: (Opens his gift, super excited) Alright! No way, Jesus! Seriously? Twenty

ounces of Coke? Yeah baby! This is awesome! Jesus, thank you so much. *(Talking to Laura)* Laura, we gotta go show Richard our gifts. Come on!

Drew exits stage right. **Jesus** looks at **Laura**, who seems disappointed.

Jesus: Hey, Laura, is there a problem?

Laura: (A bit sassy) No. I mean, well...yeah, kind of. You know, it's just that

every time you give people gifts you always give everyone else more

than you give me!

Jesus: What do you mean?

Laura: (Looking at her 8oz can) I mean, like, I open my gift and oh cute, 8

ounces. And then Drew opens his gift, and hello! Twenty ounces!



Jesus: Oh, I know what you mean. Well, that gift is for Drew!

ENDING:

Kat and **Drew** sense the awkward situation, look at each other, and slowly back off, exiting stage right.

Laura: (Upset, offended, talking to Jesus) Why are you holding back your best

from me?

Jesus: I gave you my best. Don't you see what's happening here? You're letting

everyone else's gifts steal your joy.

Laura: No, Jesus. You are stealing my joy by giving everyone else more than

you gave me!

Jesus: Laura, I picked this out for you. That's what I wanted you to see.

Laura: I don't care.

Jesus: Until you can look past this, (he grabs the 8oz can from her hand,

holding it in front of her eyes, right between the two of them, as soon as

he says, "this.") all you're going to see is a can of Coke.

Laura frustrated, exits stage right, leaving **Jesus** holding the can of Coke alone. After a moment, **Jesus** exits stage left.
