Time Approximately 3-5 minutes

Two paparazzi from Jerusalem, **Matt** and **Zach**, are sneaking into the manger in Bethlehem to get shots of the birth of a "king." They are clumsy and make noises as they enter.

Zach: Sssh! They'll hear us!

Matt: Hey...I didn't know we had to make our way through an obstacle course

of animals to get here.

Zach: We have to get closer so we can get some good photos. Hurry up!

Matt: I have to take it slow so I won't step in...aw, too late!

Zach: Stop whining! If we get these shots of the birth of the King of Israel, we'll

be set for life. No more small jobs...our names will be known all over the

world!

Matt: Maybe so...but are you sure this is the place?

Zach: Yes, I'm sure. I got the scoop from that page in Herod's court.

Matt: How do you know you can trust him?

Zach: He's a friend of my third cousin's nephew.

Matt: Well, that eases my mind.

Zach: Hey, stop worrying...I have my secondary source too!

Matt: And what might that be?

Zach: I just got a text from a shepherd friend of mine. He said he was out in

the fields tonight and all of a sudden the sky was filled with...you won't

Donkey sounds.

Zach: We'll leave our card! If you ever want any photos of your son as he gets

older!

Donkey sounds as they run off.

Lights out. The end.
