## “Ready to Walk”

- What** Lefty and Righty are two feet trying to follow Jesus in this script. Despite not knowing what they’re walking into, they decide to obey His call and go where He is leading.  
**Themes:** Trust, Obedience, Evangelism, Fishers of Men, Following Jesus
- Who** Righty  
Lefty
- When** Contemporary setting of hearing the words of Jesus
- Wear (Props)** Costumes or makeup to look like feet (Use your own creativity to make the characters look like feet. Some costume stores have shoe outfits available.)
- Why** Matthew 4:18-22, Mark 1:14-20
- How** Two feet are raring to go as they obey the call of Jesus to follow. They are a bit clumsy and struggle to work together at times.
- Time** Approximately 3 minutes

*Two feet are walking along. Lefty stumbles in pain.*

**Lefty:** *(in pain)* Ow...

**Righty:** What's wrong?

**Lefty:** I stubbed my toe!

**Righty:** Well, it's your own fault. You are trying to walk too fast. Take your time and stay close to me.

**Lefty:** I think you tripped me on purpose.

**Righty:** No way. You are just like all left feet...clumsy!

**Lefty:** *(pushes)* I'll show you who's clumsy.

**Righty:** *(pushes back)* You'd better toe the line buddy, or I'm going to put my foot down on you.

**Lefty:** *(calling each other names as they continue to struggle)* Stinky!

**Righty:** Fungus foot!

**Lefty:** Hangnail!

**Righty:** Bunion breath!

*They get tired and stop pushing after a moment or two.*

**Lefty:** Ok...ok...maybe we didn't start out on the right foot here. I guess I *was* going a little too fast.

**Righty:** No problem. I'll try to do better at keeping us in step with one another.

**Lefty:** Thanks. Maybe I was just excited.

**Righty:** We both were! After I heard Jesus say, "follow me, and I will make you fish for people," I was ready to hotfoot it anywhere he led.

**Lefty:** Yeah, it's like I didn't even think about it, I just started moving out.  
*(Crazy movement like a moonwalk)*

**Righty:** Where do you think we are going?

**Lefty:** I'm not sure. He said we would be fishing for people, so we must be heading toward some water.

**Righty:** I hope it's not too wet. I get a bad rash when I am damp for a while.

**Lefty:** I have never fished for people before...just for fish! I don't know if I will understand how to do this fishing.

**Righty:** I'm sure he will tell us how. We just have to trust. He seems to be such a great leader.

**Lefty:** He sure is...I know he'll help us put our best foot forward!

**Righty:** That would be me...the right foot for the right time!

**Lefty:** No way, I'm the best foot.

**Righty:** I am.

**Lefty:** *(starts to struggle again with Righty)* I'll show you who is best. Come here you heel!

**Righty:** *(stops all at once and looks out)* Wait!!! Hey look! There are other feet following him too!

**Lefty:** We'd better get going or we'll be eating their dust!

**Righty:** Do you think we are ready to follow Jesus?

**Lefty:** I'm ready. I just put on some new toenail polish and I'm wearing my fanciest toe ring! Oh, and I just put a little powder between my toes...just in case.

**Righty:** No, I mean, will we know how to get our foot in the door with the people we are going to be fishing for?

**Lefty:** All I know is, he said to follow him...so I am ready to walk!! He'll show us what to do when we get to the right spot! Come on...let's be fleet...foot. *(moonwalks again)*

**Righty:** Don't trip again! Let me keep us together...right, left, right, left...

*The two feet mumble and stumble as they walk off in a military style. Lights out.*
