How This skit can be used either as a promotion for SYATP[™], or for a rally celebrating

the day. Have fun with it.

Time Approximately 4-6 minutes

Cash Dawson, a popular television show host, is on the grounds of the local high school for See You at the Pole[™].

Cash: This is Cash Dawson and welcome to *Cash Time*. We are coming to you

live to from (*Local school*)'s See You at the Pole [™] celebration. As you can see many people are here this morning. We're going to ask a few people

what brought them out this early. (Sees Alice) Excuse me, miss?

Alice: Back off, I'm trying to see... (*Realizes*) CASH DAWSON! Omigosh,

omigosh, omigosh, am I on TV? (Takes microphone) I want to give a

shout to my girls Stacey, Frankie, Vicky. Aren't you jealous?

Cash: (*Gets microphone back*) Um, I take it you watch the show.

Alice: Watch it? ITIVO it. I've got every one on my hard drive. You're my idol,

Cash Dawson. I worship you. It's true, I'm not ashamed to admit it, I've

made Cash my idol.

Cash: (*Uncomfortable*) That's... nice. I was just wondering what brought you

out to See You at the Pole [™] this morning?

Alice: Is that what this is? Oh, I thought it was See Lenny's Mole.

Cash: No, it's See You at the Pole $^{\mathsf{II}}$.

Alice: What a disappointment. I'm going to get a donut. Hey, that rhymes. I'm

a poet, and didn't realize it. Bye Cash, I love you! (Exits)

Cash: That's what makes live television great. Let's see if we can find someone

else. (Sees Bobby) Sir, Cash Dawson.

Bobby: (*Confused*) What do you want me to do?

Cash: No, that's my name, Cash Dawson. I have a TV Show.

Bobby: If you say so.

Cash: Okay, let me ask you, what brought you out this morning?

Bobby: I came out to commune with nature, see the glorious miracle of the

sunrise as it beckons us toward the future.

Cash: Really?

Bobby: No. I heard there were some hot girls you could "take home to Papa," if

you get my drift.

Cash: Unfortunately, I do. Thank you for that bit of "reality TV."



Bobby: No problem, bro. (*Exiting, calling off*) Hey, Debbie, I seem to have

misplaced my phone number...

Cash: I'm going to get fired. (*Vladimir enters with a full hiking pack on*) Here

comes someone interesting.

Vladimir: Is this where is the meeting of the buses?

Cash: No, this is See You at the Pole $^{\text{TM}}$.

Vladimir: This is why I am here.

Cash: Oh, great. What in particular brought you out?

Vladimir: To be communing with the nature, to be seeing the glorious miracle of

the sunrise as it is topping the top of the world.

Cash: Pardon. But we're in (*Town and state*).

Vladimir: But I am ready to be boarding the buses to be seeing of the North Pole.

Do you know where is the meeting of the buses?

Cash: Um... (*Points off*) That way.

Vladimir: Thanking you. (*Exits*)

Cash: (*Hand to ear*) It seems we have a caller. Yes, Karen from Connecticut,

how are you?

Karen: (*Offstage*) Hey, are you at See You at the Pole[™]?

Cash: Yes, we are? Where are you?

Karen: I'm at our school's flagpole.

Cash: How's it going over there?

Karen: Nothing like where you are. My friends said that you were going to be

doing this show, so we brought a TV to see it. I have to say your See You

at the Pole[™] looks better than ours.

Cash: You don't say.

Karen: Yeah, I mean there're more people there, the music's better, everyone

looks like they're having more fun. I mean, maybe it's just the TV, but

even the grass seems greener over where you are.
