Time Approximately 3-5 minutes

Zipporah enters with water pitchers as if headed home from the well.

Zipporah: Hi there and welcome to Midian. My name is Zipporah. You may know me better as the wife of Moses. You've heard of Moses haven't you? Well, just in case you may have him confused with another Moses, I've made this little slide show. Lights!

(Slide show with this narration. Slide 1- adult **Moses'** face in a basket) This is Moses as a baby. Isn't he cute? (Slide 2 shows slavery) During the time Moses was a baby, his people- well, God's people, the Israelites, were slaves in Egypt. (Slide 3- Pharaoh instructing the death of baby boys) Pharaoh, the leader of Egypt, ordered all the baby boys to be killed. (Slide 4- Miriam putting the basket in the Nile) Moses' mom made a basket and sealed it with tar and sent him drifting down the Nile under the watchful eye of his sister, Miriam. (Slide 5- daughter looking in the basket and seeing adult **Moses'** face) Pharaoh's daughter found him and decided to raise him as her son. (Slide 6- Moses in his current clothing and a sign that says "different", Egyptians that look exactly alike with "same." Maybe play a tune "one of these things doesn't belong") Some time later, he realized he was different from his Egyptian family. After an "unfortunate accident," these slides are part of an ongoing investigation so we couldn't include those; it became clear to him that it was his time to go. That's how he ended up here- with me. God has a plan and when it's time He will tell us what that plan is. (She walks away and **Moses** enters.)

Moses:

(Enters down the stage calling his sheep and apparently enjoying being in the mountain air. On the stage, a bush comes to life with flames from an angel.) Here lammy, lammy, SHEEP, lammy. Here lammy, lammy, lammy, lammy.

ENDING:

God: Now put your hand inside your coat. (If using modern wear, you could

have Moses put his hand inside his backpack).

Moses: Leprosy! (He puts his hand back in quickly, pulls it out and sighs with

relief. Then he looks inside his coat, with a curious expression.)



Moses: Um, God, I think you've got the wrong man. I get ton...tried tounged...I

don't speak so good.

God: Who is God and who is Moses, huh?

Moses: P-p-p-please, send someone else.

God: (In a calm stern tone) Take your brother Aaron the Levite. I know he can

speak. He is already on his way. I will help both of you speak and will

teach you what to do. Now take your staff. You'll need it.

Lights fade. The end.
