**Who** Teacher

**Wear** Desk

(**Props**) Teaching material

Backpacks for children

Wordless book, Gospel tract, sharing bracelet (with colored beads)

**Why** Romans 10:9, 1 Peter 3:15, John 3:16

**How** Keep this conversational, especially with the kids. Don't be overdramatic.

**Time** Approximately 3-5 minutes

Scene opens with the **Teacher** wrapping up the lesson.

**Teacher:** I'm glad you were here today. See you next week. (Immediately turns to

pick up stuff to leave).

Child 1: (Approaching her/him) Mr./Mrs.\_\_\_\_\_, I was wondering...well,

I've been thinking a lot about Jesus lately.

**Teacher:** (Hurriedly) Great! I'm so glad to hear that. If you have any guestions be

sure and let me know. (Starts to walk off.)

**Child 1:** (Quickly) Can I ask you something?

**Teacher:** (Shoulders tense up in response) Uh...sure.

**Child 1:** During Easter, I heard a lot about Jesus dying on the cross for my sin.

And, (pause) I'm ready!

**Teacher:** You're ready?

**Child 1:** Yes, to do whatever I'm supposed to do now.

**Teacher:** Wow! That's great! (*Pause*) All you have to do...well, first you...you

know, our Pastor would love to share with you how you can come to

know Christ as your Lord and Savior.

**Child 1:** (Disappointed) O.K. (Gets up and starts walking off. Pauses and turns.)

Thanks.

**Teacher:** Glad I could help!

**Child 1** walks slowly toward where the Pastor is seated, looks at him and then turn and walks off where he/she is intercepted by **Child 2**.

**Child 2:** Hey, what's wrong with you?

**Child 1:** Nothing, it doesn't matter.

**Child 2:** Did you have to go to church this morning?

**Child 1:** Yeah.

**Child 2:** Thought so. I've been there myself.

**Child 1:** I don't want to talk about it. Come on. Let's go ride bikes.
