- What** This Reader's Theatre is a companion piece for The Call of Christmas program package, rounding out the series on Christmas morning. It can also be used as a stand-alone piece. **Themes:** Christmas, Purpose, Emmanuel, Go tell
- Who** Reader 1
Reader 2
Reader 3
- When** Present
- Wear** If reading from your script, each Reader should have matching black binders.
(Props)
- Why** Matthew 28:16-20
- How** We recommend that each Reader memorize their lines. The dialogue should flow as if one person is speaking.
Some ideas for this script:
Use this as a stand-alone piece in your Christmas worship service.
Perform it live with the video, The Call of Christmas Anthem available on SkitGuys.com.
Incorporate it into your Christmas Eve candlelight service.
- Time** Approximately 3 minutes

Readers address the audience.

Reader 2: Urging them to follow.

Reader 1: Asking them to trust.

Reader 2: The stories have been told for centuries

Reader 3: The people have been waiting

Reader 1: The wait is nearly over

Reader 2: The time is now

Reader 3: Today our Savior is born
To bring light into dark places

Reader 2: To be the voice in the wilderness

Reader 1: To call you to come home

Reader 2: To bring joy to the world

Reader 1: God has chosen you and he does not make mistakes

Reader 3: God's timing is not our timing

Reader 1: His love is not our love

Reader 2: He has turned his love into flesh and blood

Reader 3: And for that, we rejoice

Reader 2: Emmanuel

Reader 1: So don't wait. Don't pack. Don't plan

Reader 2: Just. Go.

Reader 3: There is a world, lost and hungry

Reader 2: There is a world, lonely and wandering

Reader 1: And he has called us to go and tell them.

Reader 2: Go and tell them what God is doing.
