**How** This skit can be all girls, all guys or a mixture of both. The adult in the skit can

be a male or female as well, but needs to be bigger than life. When children are together they have tons of energy, so make sure you do! If the actors are having fun, the audience will have fun. Remember - kids will say big words, but they are

innocent in nature.

**Time** Approximately 4-6 minutes

Lights are low and flashlights are on. Kid 1 has flashlight under his face.

Kid 1: And every Halloween night he comes out from his dungeon and he

takes his claw and he looks for kindergartners to eat so he can get really full to sleep for another year until Halloween comes again.

All other little kids react in terror.

Kid 2: Say no more! Say no more! I'm so scared. I'm going to have to sleep

with my parents.

**Kid 3:** I wet myself.

**Kid 4:** My turn. My turn to tell a Halloween story...There was this one time..

**Kid 2:** Didn't you hear me! My five years in this world are telling me I am

not able to handle any more of these true to life stories of betrayal,

murder, lost love and paranormal phenomenon.

**Kid 1:** Do you even know what you are saying?

**Kid 2:** Unfortunately. I watch a lot of CSI.

**Kid 4:** Enough! My turn. I heard on Halloween that the old lady that lives in

the house down the street...

**Kid 1:** You mean the one with all the cats?

**Kid 4:** The exact - same - evil - one.

**Kid 3:** I love CATS!!

All little kids stop what they are doing and look at **Kid 3** as if to say, "you are such a dork".

**Kid 4:** Enough!! I'm so sure. Now, listen to what I am telling you. It could

save your life.

**Kid 2:** The only thing that can save your life is forensic evidence.

Now, all the little kids look at **Kid 2** as the dork.

**Kid 4:** They say...

**Kid 3** raises hand high in the air as in trying to ask a question.

**Kid 4:** Every Halloween she puts a potion in - (keeps looking at **Kid 3** with
