How	Keep in mind this is a set-up piece. It's meant to be an "opener;" something to get the crowd involved and students involved. You would need to go to a video or something else after this "skit bit". You may even want to bring back the nerds running throughout the program, like they are lost, or cannot seem to find a seat, or some other creative invention. You could ask them questions and continue the opener, but just keep in mind these type of bits can run long and "feel" a bit overdone. Have the actors practice high energy all the way through. It will make the nerds coming out a complete surprise and very funny.	
Time	Approximately 2-4 minutes	

Phil Callahan, talk show host, addresses the audience. There are eight chairs across the stage.

Host: Welcome ladies and gentlemen to the show. I'm Phil Callahan. We have a great show for you tonight. One of the best. Let's get on with it. Today, we are going to be meeting some of the most beautiful women in the world. So here they are. All the way from Louisiana, here she is Miss Louisiana, Carole Tucker, ladies and gentlemen. (Miss Louisiana enters) And without further adieu, here is Miss Alabama, Mary Ann Jenkins. (Miss Alabama enters) Moving on, from the Golden State, here she is, bronze beauty, Miss California, Kristina Barbie. (Miss California enters) And last but not least, from the Hot State where she just won the pageant, Miss Arizona, Samantha Taylor. (Miss Arizona enters) Let me start with some questions. Miss Louisiana, I suppose you have a boyfriend?

Louisiana: Yes.

Host: And if you could describe your boyfriend in one word what would that be?

Louisiana: That would definitely be... "manly".

Host: Manly. Alright, Miss Alabama, are you married?

Alabama: Engaged.

Host: Can you describe a typical date that you and your fiancée would go on?

Alabama: A dozen long-stemmed roses, red of course, fly me out to San Francisco to see the opera, fly me home. That kind of thing.

Host: Miss California, you know that song, "Nothing you could do could take me away from my guy?" Does that hold true for your life?

California: Definitely.

Host: Okay, you're in California, a lot of great guys there. Tell me, does your boyfriend ever get tired of it?

California: He is very supportive of me.

Host: Does he go with you to the pageants?
