Why John 3:30; Psalm 9:10; Matthew 19:16-26; John 15; Romans 12:1-2

How Keep the pacing and energy up and the dialogue conversational.

Time Approximately 2-4 minutes

Kat enters from stage left, carrying a stool. **Jesus** enters from stage right. They meet at center stage, where **Kat** sets the stool down, then places her hands on **Jesus'** shoulders to sit him down on the stool.

Kat: (Excitedly, as she sits Jesus down) Jesus, I have decided to give you this

(indicating the stool).

Jesus: (Settling in on the stool, honored) Really? Kat, you know whomever sits

here makes all of the decisions.

Kat: (Standing back on the stage left side of **Jesus**) I know, Jesus...but your

decisions are perfect, so giving this to you is my last decision!

Jesus: (Settling onto the seat) Wow. I'm honored. This feels great!

Laura: (Entering excitedly from stage left to join **Kat**) Okay, Kat, my new credit

card came today. It's time to go shopping!

Kat: (Puzzled, turning to look at Laura) I thought you and your husband

were trying get debt-free.

Laura: Yeah, I know- money is tight. But I really want some new stuff. My

husband doesn't have to know about it. Do you want to go?

Jesus: (Immediately giving **Kat** her answer) No.

Kat: (Hearing and repeating **Jesus'** answer while sliding onto the stool,

almost pushing him off, still looking at Laura) No?

Laura: (Confused) Why?

Kat: (Realizing what she just said and quickly changing her answer as she

shares the stool with **Jesus**) I mean, I don't know. I have to check my

schedule and let you know.

Laura: Oh sure. No problem. Just give me a call.

Laura exits stage left. **Jesus** immediately speaks to **Kat**, who is still on the stool with him.

Jesus: Kat, what's going on here?

Kat: (Innocently) What do you mean?

Jesus: I'm kind of one-cheekin' it here. I just want to make sure we're on the

same page. You wanted me to sit here, right?

Kat: Oh. Of course!

ENDING:

Kat: I know. It's you. I just didn't think it would be this hard.

Jesus: (Placing hands on the opposite side of the stool from **Kat**) Kathleen, I'm

not going to take it. You have to give it to me.

Kat: I know.

Jesus: So, make a choice.

Kat: (Bringing the stool back close to her body, pulling it away from **Jesus**,

then speaking emphatically) I can't.

Jesus: (Seriously) You just did.

They stand there a moment, then exit their respective sides, **Kat** carrying the stool off with her.

Lights out. The end.

Discussion Questions:

- 1. Are you currently living like the branch or the vine?
- 2. What happens when you give Jesus the authority in your life?
- 3. Why is it so hard to give up control of things?
- 4. What does God say about taking care of us?
- 5. Has God ever been wrong?
