Scripture Readings are tricky. They can come across as "cheesy" if the piece How hasn't been read through by the readers. The great thing about a reading is the

leader has the ability to print this up and pick three people to do it the day of the event. It's also a great reminder to sit and listen to scripture and hear what

we've forgotten on certain subjects of our lives.

Make sure the readers have the piece down. There are parts that weave together between the three readers. If it is off a bit, it will mess up the rhythm of the piece. If they don't get it down, it's better to break it up in chunks instead of

line to line.
