**Why** 1 Corinthians 13:4-7

**How** This reading is suggested for the maid of honor and best man as Reader 1 and

Reader 2. However, it could also be used by the parents of the bride and groom. The congregation and all the wedding party repeats "to have and to hold" each time. The scripture is to be read by everyone, including the bride and groom. If there is a situation in which the audience cannot respond as a whole (such as an

outdoor wedding) simply have Readers 1 and 2 read it together.

**Time** Approximately 1 minute

**Reader 2:** Bound in love by the Father

**Reader 1:** And saved by His Son.

**Reader 1:** In making a vow as you start on your way.

**Reader 1:** This day that you planned

Reader 2: Will make memories so dear.

**Reader 1:** With such hope in your eyes

Reader 1: We pray God shows you favor

ALL: To have and to hold.

Reader 2: May you lean on each other

**Reader 1:** Putting trust in the Lord

Reader 2: Always bathe things in prayer

**Reader 1:** Build your home on His word.

**Reader 2:** It won't always be easy

Reader 1: Life brings hardships untold

**Reader 2:** But we stay alongside you

ALL: To have and to hold.
