## "Trust Fall"

**What** If you've ever struggled with trusting Jesus, this is for you. Learn how human

nature often keeps us from the very thing that will help us trust Him more.

Themes: Faith, Doubt, Trust, Choices, Obedience

**Who** Jesus

Laura

**When** Present

**Wear** None

(Props)

**Why** Psalm 32:8-10, Proverbs 3:5-6, John 14:1

**How** Have fun with this. Keep the dialogue moving and be sure to practice the trust

falls.

**Time** Approximately 2-4 minutes

Laura enters stage left, Jesus enters stage right. They meet center stage.

**Laura:** (Hesitantly) Jesus, I just don't trust you.

**Jesus:** You don't trust me?

**Laura:** No, I mean I wanna trust you...I just don't.

**Jesus:** (Smiling) I have an exercise that I think will really help you.

**Laura:** Oh, okay.

Jesus: Stand here and face this direction. (Jesus turns Laura so she's facing

away from him, then he takes a few steps back from her) Now...do you

trust me?

**Laura:** (Confused, turning around) Uh, no. I just said I don't trust you.

**Jesus:** Alright, well, this is all part of the exercise.

**Laura:** Oh right. Okay.

**Jesus:** When I ask you if you trust me, you say, "Yes, Jesus, I trust you."

**Laura:** Even though I don't?

**Jesus:** It's practice.

**Laura:** Okay. (She turns to face forward again.)

**Jesus:** So, do you trust me?

**Laura:** (Slowly, practicing, slightly sarcastic) Yes, Jesus, I trust you.

**Jesus:** Now...fall back.

**Laura:** (Shocked, she turns to face **Jesus**) Are you gonna catch me?

**Jesus:** Don't worry about that part.

**Laura:** Okay, that's the part I'm really worried about!

**Jesus:** You can do this, okay? Just trust me.

**Laura:** (Skeptically) Trust you.

**Jesus:** Just fall back.

**Laura:** (Still skeptical) Okay, well, Jesus, I trust you. (She sighs, puts her arms

out, glances behind her, then faces forward and slowly takes a few steps



back until she's less than a foot from him. She gently leans back onto **Jesus**, then jumps forward, proud of herself, as if she actually fell) Woohoo. Great.

**Jesus:** Uh, let's try again. (*Jesus turns her around again*) Just face this direction

and keep your feet planted. Alright. Do you trust me?

**Laura:** (Exasperated) Yes, Jesus...I trust you.

Jesus: Now...fall back.

**Laura:** (Scared, nervous, but now determined) Okay. I'm gonna do it.

Jesus: Alright.

**Laura:** I'm really going to do it.

Jesus: Good.

**Laura** waits a few seconds, takes a breath, then falls backward into **Jesus'** arms, screaming. When **Jesus** catches her, she jumps up, ecstatic.

**Laura:** Whoa! Jesus! You really caught me! I didn't think you were gonna catch

me, but you did!

**Jesus:** YAY! That was great!

**Laura:** So great!

**Jesus:** You're ready for level two!

**Laura:** Level two? Here I come, baby! Woo-hoo!

She turns her back to **Jesus** and starts to immediately fall, like she did the last time.

**Jesus:** (Stopping her with his arms) Whoa! Okay, hold it.

**Laura:** Oh, you know what? You're too close. You need to move back.

**Jesus:** Oh. Right. This one's a little bit different.
