- When** Present
- Wear (Props)** Purse for Memaw
- Why** Proverbs 22:6; Deuteronomy 6:6-7
- How** Change the names of Tommy and Eddie to whoever is doing the skit. Their parts can also be played by women. Have fun and make this your own! Visit SkitGuys.com and watch the video for more ideas.
- Time** Approximately 2-3 minutes

Tommy and Eddie enter and address the audience.

Eddie: Hey! Tommy and Eddie here! We want to share with you about a great opportunity happening right here in our church.

Tommy: Yeah! In fact, we have a very special guest here to help us today.

Eddie: She's my grandmother and I love her so much! I call her Memaw. Come on in here Memaw! Help us out!

Memaw walks onstage, but sort of wanders off.

Eddie: Memaw? Memaw?

Eddie guides her over to where he and Tommy are standing.

Tommy: We're getting ready for VBS, that wonderful time of year where the children of our community join us to learn about the God who loves us so much.

Eddie: Yes, and my Memaw has been helping out with VBS for the past 20 years.

Memaw: Forty-three years!

Tommy: Well, let's just say a long time.

Memaw: *(Gives Tommy a stern look)* Forty-three years.

Eddie is behind her giving Tommy the signal to just drop it and leave it alone.

Tommy: But it's really just a... *(sees Eddie, says quietly)* She never liked me.

Memaw: *(To the audience)* I make cookies for the kiddies.

Eddie: She does. My Memaw makes some of the best cookies for the kids!

Tommy: If you like the taste of play-dough.

Eddie: What?!

Tommy: *(To audience)* Here's the deal, Memaw needs your help.

Memaw: No I don't!

Tommy: Yes you do.

Eddie: She doesn't.

Memaw: No, I don't.

Tommy: You do! If you'll just listen, the whole point of this- *(he points at Memaw and she slaps his hand)* Ow!

Eddie: *(Moving on)* Many wonderful people, just like my Memaw, have helped out with VBS over the years. Whether it's been crowd control, making cookies, helping with games, teaching the kids...we want to give you the chance to get involved to encourage the kids through VBS.

Tommy: So look, let's give Memaw a break.

Memaw: I'll give you a break.

Memaw slaps her hand on Tommy's shoulder and he goes down.

Tommy: Pressure point!

Eddie: Here's the point! Get involved! This is your time! This is the summer for you to rise up and say "Yes! I'll be involved with VBS!" Just like my Memaw has been for the past 43 years.

Tommy finally stands back up.

Eddie: You were kind of passed out.

Tommy: When'd your Memaw get here?

Eddie: She's been here the whole time.

Tommy: Oh. It's good to see you. *(Back to audience)* So let's all work together and give Memaw a rest.

Eddie: What are you doing?

Tommy: She looks tired.

Memaw: I've had it! That's it! I'll put you to rest!

Memaw smacks Tommy in the face with her purse and continues to "beat" him as they exit off stage.

Eddie: *(To Memaw)* Be easy with him, Memaw! *(Back to audience)* So! There you have it! Get involved! Change some lives this summer. We need you at VBS!
