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- What** Do our media choices really matter? If "out of the overflow of the heart the mouth speaks," what does it look like when we fill our hearts with inappropriate media? Check out this script to find out. **Themes:** Purity, Media, Discernment, Movies
- Who** Drew
Ryan
- When** Present
- Wear (Props)** Bowl
Tortilla Chips with Vomit (made of oatmeal with water and red food coloring)
Two Chairs
- Why** Matthew 12:33-35; Psalm 24:3-6; Philippians 4:8
- How** Keep things moving along with pacing and energy. The two actors playing Drew and Ryan should be fearless and very comfortable on stage. Have fun with this one!
- Time** Approximately 4-6 minutes

*Two chairs are set up side by side, center stage. **Ryan** and **Drew** walk onstage from stage left, with **Ryan** leading, stepping carefully, as if walking into a movie theater. As they walk and look for open seats, they speak to each other.*

Drew: Hurry up, Ryan. I hate being late for the movies.

Ryan: Well, if you wouldn't have stopped at that red light, we wouldn't be late!

Drew: Oh c'mon now. It's a red light!

Ryan: Oh, there's some open seats (*points to two chairs on stage*).

Drew: Well, hurry up and get in there so we can at least see the previews.

***Drew** and **Ryan** move towards the chairs, "stepping over" the other movie patrons, as if they were scooting down a row of theater seats.*

Ryan: (*Shocked, reacting to being "grabbed" by a patron he passes*) Hey! Watch it, lady!

Drew: Sit down, man! Hurry!

Ryan: Careful, 'cause that one has claws! (***Ryan** and **Drew** sit down in their chairs*) Well, at least we get to see this preview.

Drew: The previews are my favorite part.

Ryan: Oh, you should have seen the preview before this one. That movie is gonna be awesome! We've gotta go see it.

Drew: Wait, you've got the previews memorized?

Ryan: Oh yeah! I've seen this movie seven times already!

Drew: Wow. It's that good?

Ryan: Yeah, it's great! And what could be better than getting in to see it for free?

Drew: I know, man. Your cousin was so nice to let us in here.

Ryan: Yeah, it pays to have a cousin who's the manager! Anyway, we gotta see that one movie.

Drew: (*Pointing at the screen and whispering*) Dude, shhhh, the movie is starting.

Ryan: Oh it's just the credits. Who cares about those? I gotta tell you about that preview. It was for this new flick called, "Attack of the Alien Fungus!"

It starts out with this fungus that's shot down to earth from outer space and starts growing on this shower wall, right? And then this poodle walks by, and the fungus reaches out and swallows the poodle! I don't know what a poodle is doing in the shower but...

Drew is trying to ignore Ryan and focus on the movie. The two of them suddenly jump and scream at the same time, as if reacting to a scene they just saw.

Drew: *(Shocked and horrified)* What was that?

Ryan: *(Laughing)* That was awesome!

Drew: What are you talking about? That was disgusting.

Ryan: Yeah, that old lady didn't see the semi coming! HONK-HONK! Watch it, lady! Ha ha ha ha!

Drew: Dude, that was really disturbing.

Ryan: No, that's called an attention-getter!

Drew: Yeah, it got my attention when her brains hit the camera! C'mon man. You know I don't like a lot of blood and gore in movies. I thought you said this was gonna be good?

Ryan: Oh, it is! The best part about this movie is that it has something for everyone! Just get past the bad stuff, like the stuff you don't like, and wait for the good stuff. Oh, like this next scene. If you're a romantic, this part is for you.

Drew: *(Nervous)* What do you mean?

Ryan: Well, see that blonde *(points to the screen)?*

Drew: Yeah.

Ryan: And that guy?

Drew: *(Hesitant)* Yeah.

Ryan: Well, things between them are about to get a little steamy, if you know what I mean.
