- What** Anna has a terrific spiritual experience and is faced with the question: Will you love me now? (Themes: Making the Decision to Follow Christ)
- Who** Narrator 1
Narrator 2
Anna
Jesus
- When** Present day
- Wear (Props)** None
- Why** Deuteronomy 31:6
- How** The sketch should follow “With You Always”- Part I. Both sketches were designed for a camp or retreat and work great in that context. But it can also be used in a youth service by simply changing Anna’s camp experience to more specific daily events that your students can relate to. In this sketch, Anna is more “in tune” with Jesus, and less hostile, but she still can not look him in the eye.
- Time** Approximately 4-6 minutes

Scene One: Narrators introduce the skit and then exit.

Narrator 1: The first night of camp we performed a sketch where you met a teenage girl named Anna. Anna was going to a church camp, yet she said she wasn't really ready for the whole Jesus thing.

Narrator 2: Anna had heard a lot about Jesus and had even accepted Him at a young age, yet she told Jesus she wasn't ready to live his way.

Narrator 1: In fact she told Jesus to leave her alone. But of course He couldn't.

Narrator 2: Now it's Thursday night and Anna has spent a week at camp.

Narrator 1: Jesus told her he couldn't leave her alone this week.

Narrator 2: And of course He didn't.

*Scene Two: Putting on make up and dancing like she did in "With You Always" – Part I, but **Anna** still can't look at **Jesus** in the face, even though she is having a friendlier conversation with him.*

Jesus: Did you have fun this week?

Anna: Yes Jesus, I had a great time.

Jesus: Yeah?

Anna: Yeah, you know at first I was like I can't believe I am going to have to spend an entire week with a bunch of church geeks, then I ended up hanging out with Beth on the way up. She's really cool.

Jesus: Yeah?

Anna: Yeah, like me. Just kidding. But to be honest, I was really dreading the first night of worship. When we went in, I thought, "oh no, here we go". First we'll sing, then some guy will preach, then we'll sing again, then everyone will come down to the front and leave crying.

Jesus: Was it like that?

Anna: No not really. Well, yeah kind of. But for some reason it was different.

Jesus: Why?

Anna: *(This is a great place to insert your own specific things that happened at camp or to **Anna** specifically (i.e. The band was cool. The speaker was fantastic.) Have fun with it.)*

Jesus: So you had a great time, huh?

Anna: Yeah.

Jesus: Did you see me there, Anna?

Anna: All the time. It felt weird, but okay. You know?

Jesus: Yes, I do know.

Anna: I even went down the aisle one night and talked to... well... You. Why am I telling you all this, you were there.

Jesus: Yes I was, but did you see me?

Anna: *(Emphatically)* Yeah, I just said I heard and sang about you a lot.

Jesus: No, I mean did you see, see me?

Anna: What?

Jesus: Did you truly see me?

Anna: I don't get it?
