**What** Zeke (aka Isaac) is preparing for a trip to the mountains with his dad, Abe (aka

Abraham). Zeke feels uneasy about the trip and talks about it with his friend Gabe. **Themes:** Abraham, Isaac, Sacrifice, Trusting God, Obeying Parents,

Respect

Who Abe,

(Props)

Zeke, Gabe

**When** Would work well set in Bible times or modern. Takes place outdoors where Zeke

is gathering supplies for the trip.

**Wear** Props can be what you have on hand that work well for the scene and give Zeke

something to do during the dialogue.

Suggestions include:

Rope

Logs and kindling

Backpack or sack. Can be a dark colored pillow case

Sleeping bag (if you go modern)

Water bottle/canteen

Shirts and pants he can shove into the backpack or sack

**Why** Genesis 22:1-18

**How** Keep the dialogue conversational and energetic between the two friends. Give

them some inside jokes, like a secret handshake, etc., to show the depth of the

friendship.

**Time** Approximately 3 minutes

**Zeke** is onstage unenthusiastically packing for his trip to the woods. He is unhappy. His buddy **Gabe** comes bounding in, excited. Would work well to have him play/mess with the items **Zeke** is trying to pack.

**Gabe:** *(enthusiastically)* Zeke! Two words dude, Video Game Weekend! Yeah!

(Goes in for a high five/bro shake)

**Zeke:** *(not so excited)* That's three words, genius.

**Gabe:** Whatever, dude, you're missing the point here, video games! Are you in

or what?

**Zeke:** Nah, man, I can't. I have to go to the mountains with my dad.

**Gabe:** Like a day trip? Or is it going to blow your whole weekend?

**Zeke:** I don't know. He hasn't told me anything. He's being all mysterious. I

can't tell if I'm in trouble or if he has some kind of surprise for me.

**Gabe:** What's he been doing that's mysterious?

**Zeke:** He won't answer my questions, first of all. Then, when I walk into the

room, he changes the TV channel like he doesn't want me to see what

he's watching.

**Gabe:** What's he watching?

**Zeke:** Survivor, Man vs. Food, the Walking Dead and Phineas and Ferb.

**Gabe:** That doesn't sound so unusual.

**Zeke:** It is for him...except Phineas and Ferb. He loves that show! All I know is

that this trip means a lot to him; and, apparently, there's going to be a

huge feast. Look at all this fire wood we're taking.

**Gabe:** Bro, that's enough fire wood to cook a whole flock of sheep. You'll be

lucky if it's just the weekend.

**Zeke:** Great.

**Abe:** Zeke. Time to go, son.

**Zeke:** Yes, Dad. (*Pauses then blurts out excitedly*) Hey, can Gabe go with us?

Gabe: (stands super straight, his eyes are wide open like he's scared but

doesn't want to let his bro down. After a few seconds, he puts on a fake

smile to Abe)

**Abe:** Not this time.



Gabe: (relaxes his whole body quickly, hunches over putting his hands on his

knees and breathes heavy like someone who just finished running and

is out of breath.)

**Zeke:** Ok. Be right out.

**Gabe:** Duuude. You are in so much trouble.

Zeke: (hard sigh) Yep.

Gabe: Just don't go. Tell him you're sick.

**Zeke:** I can't lie to my dad. I respect him...and I trust him. Plus, he has a special

bond with the man upstairs.

**Gabe:** *(looking confused)* Mr. Rosencranse?

**Zeke:** Dude...really?

Gabe: What? Mr. Rosencranse is cool for an old guy. (Excitedly) One time he

pulled his... (Thinks about it) Ohhhh. THAT Man upstairs. Good luck,

dude. (Gabe exits)

**Zeke:** (gathering the essentials and walking to his father) I'm ready. (Looks

around) So, what's on the menu?

**Abe:** God will provide. (*Pauses*) Come, it's a long journey.

**Zeke:** (looks around sadly like he's never coming back.)

**Abe:** (putting his hand on **Zeke's** shoulder) Come on...we'll be back soon.

They exit as lights fade.

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
